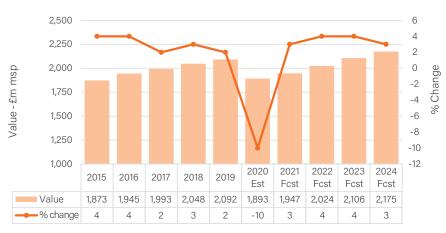

UK FLOORCOVERINGS MARKET SIZE AND FORECASTS 2015 - 2024 BY VALUE (£M AT MSP)

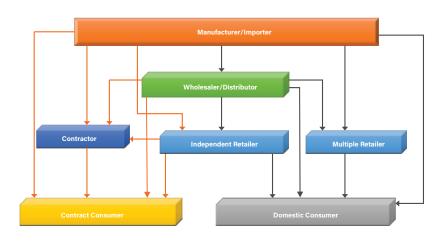

MAIN DISTRIBUTION CHANNELS FOR THE UK FLOORCOVERINGS MARKET



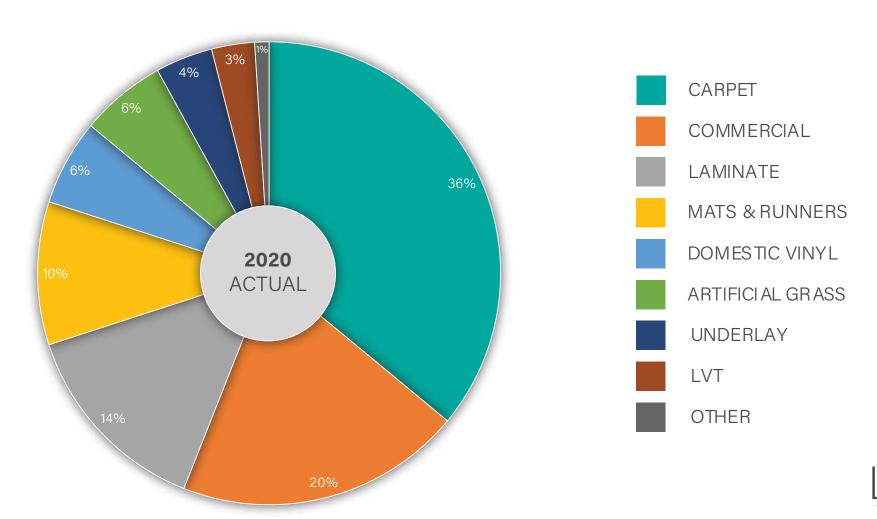

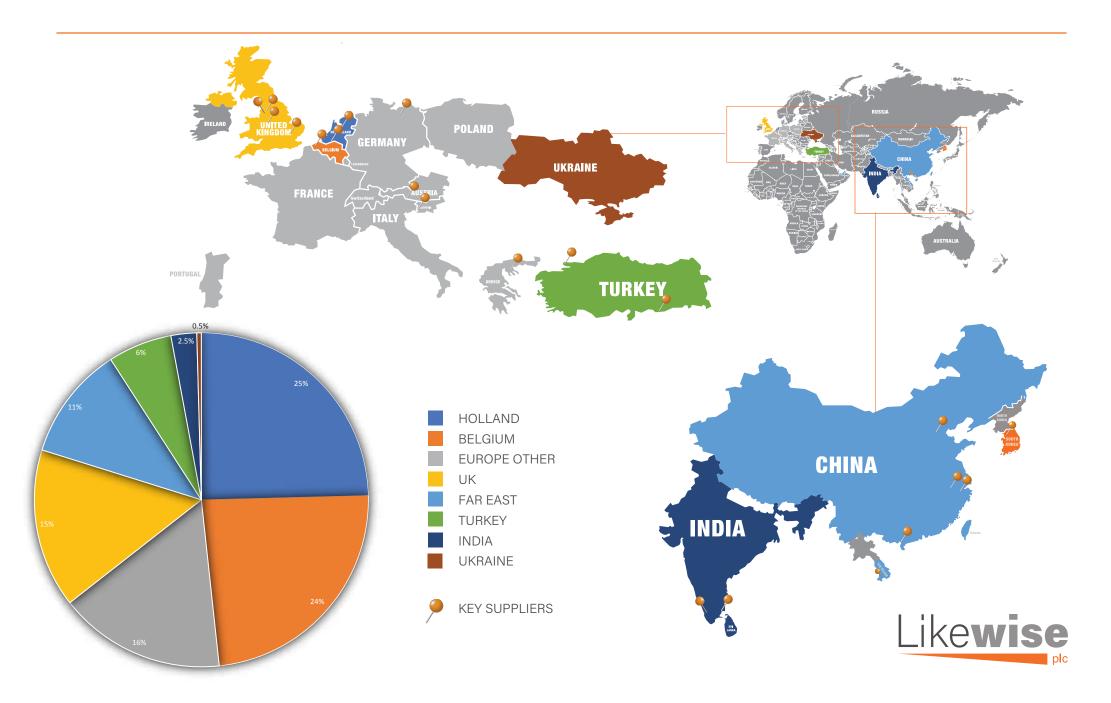

SUPPLIERS BY REGION



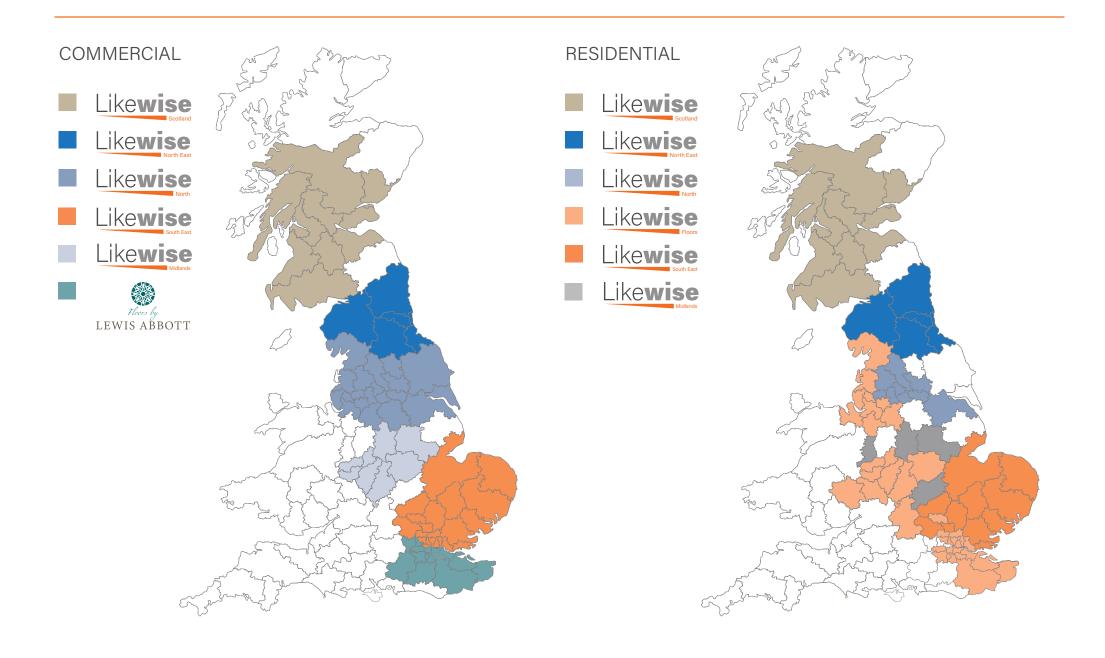
